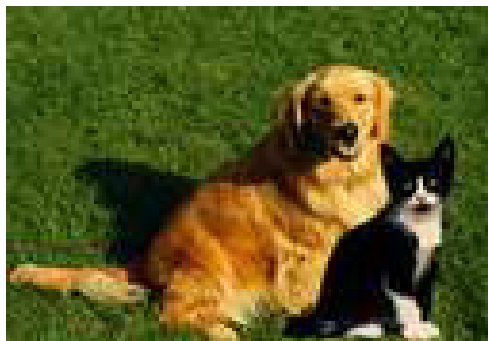

## Parish Health Ministry

### Bites from Mammals

Dog bites are the most common animal bites for which people in the US seek medical attention. Dog bites are unlikely to become infected but the risk of infection is higher in the elderly, and people with diabetes, vascular disease and alcoholism. The risk of infection is also higher in puncture wounds and wounds on the hands or feet or over a joint or in crush injuries.

Cat bites are the second most common mammal bites in the US. The infection rate for cat bites is reported to be 30-50% — more than double that for dogs. Cat scratch



disease is an infection occurring after manor scratches and is characterized by a non-tender bump at the site followed 1-2 weeks later by enlarged lymph glands and fever. Symptoms may be treated with an antibiotic.

Minor bites can be treated at home by cleansing the area with soap and applying a dressing. If in doubt or for more extensive wounds, people should contact their health care provider or go to a local emergency room for treatment. There is a general consensus among physicians that antibiotics be given for certain wounds in all patients and most wounds in certain patients. Tetanus shots should be given if over five years since the last shot in major wounds and if over 10 years since the last shot in minor wounds.

May 20, 2010

The meeting was opened in prayer by Fr. Willmann.

- The agenda for the evening and minutes of the April meeting were approved as presented.
- Sr. Warden John Benson presented financial information on the endowment funds. To balance the 2010 budget the quarterly draw was increased and there is concern that it may be necessary for another increase in 2011 to cover additional expense of medical insurance for the secretary and sexton. The next stewardship campaign will be critical.
- Jr. Warden Barbara Saunders reported that she is continuing investigation to resolve the cracking and flaking problems with the steps.
- Barbara reported that there is a possibility that a parishioner can buy discounted flooring and install it in the chapel.
- Fr. Willmann thanked everyone for their hard work in making his installation service such a lovely affair. There were 187 people in attendance
- On May 23 the parish will honor 2010 graduates.

- Fr. Rob said that there have been visitors attending both Sunday services recently. Some have found us by visiting the website.
- Treasurer Rick Meyer said that pledge income is at a good level and for the most part the budget is on track although there are a few areas of expense which need to be watched.
- Deacon Howell would like to update the webpage. He is asking for artistic help from the congregation in this area. He is also considering a change of providers. One option is service provided through the diocese.
- Fr. Rob announced a presentation for the deanery at St. James on June 6 at 3 pm. Mr. Michael Davis will speak on the topic: "Partnerships in Philanthropy. This will include approaches to initiating and successfully implementing Capital Campaigns, growing Stewardship in parishes and how to encourage Estate Bequests. (Contact the office by June 4 if you plan to attend.)

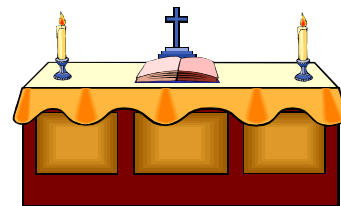
Meeting adjourned at 8:45 with Paul Reichardt leading the group in Compline.
