Tyson Kumorowski will be our cantor.



KROGER REWARDS ~

This information is from the Kroger web site.

- 1. Create a digital account.
 - A digital account is needed to participate in Kroger Community Rewards. If you already have a digital account, simply link your Shopper's Card to your account so that all transactions apply toward the organization you choose.
- 2 Link your Card to an organization. Selecting the organization that you wish to support is as simple as updating the Kroger Community Rewards selection on your digital account.
- 3 Sign into your digital account.
- 4 Search for your organization here.

Enter the name or NPO number of the organization you wish to support. I have two different numbers – AN554 or 81134 or search for St James Episcopal Church and include Zanesville to aid your search


Select the appropriate organization from the list and click "Save".
